

# Setting up your ITC Email

Select your method of email: **IMAP** or **POP3**

## IMAP

**Popular setting**—majority of users utilize this method.

This method will allow you to quickly view emails anywhere and everywhere. IMAP lets you sync folders between your home computer clients, your phone, and on Webmail, so that you see the same folders and messages wherever and however you access your email.

*Default email storage is 4GB. Please consult ITC email storage policies.*

## POP3

This method will download your inbox on your computer and not any other folders. When an email is downloaded using POP3, it is then deleted from the server and only accessible on that computer's client.

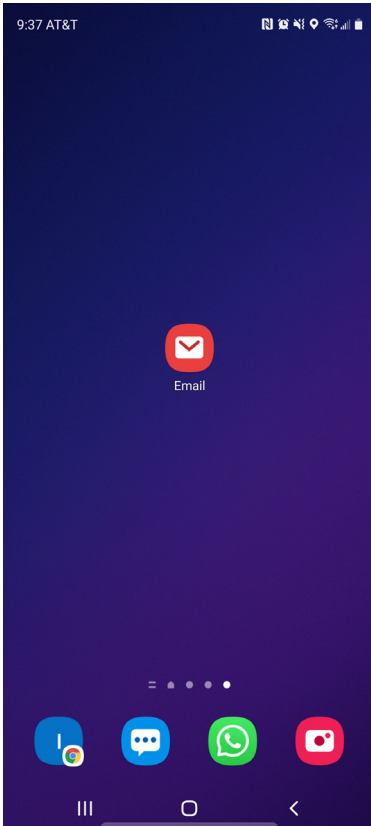

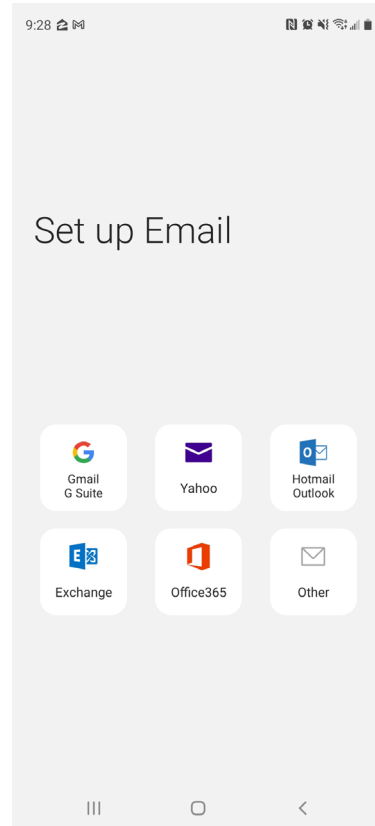

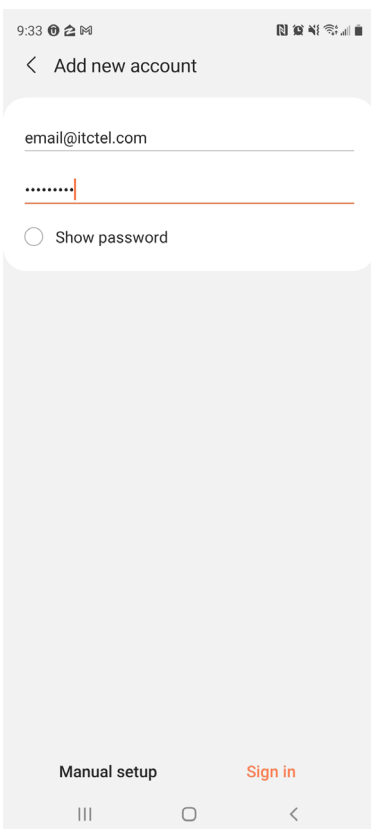
On your phone, touch the email button. This will open up the Set Up Email screen.

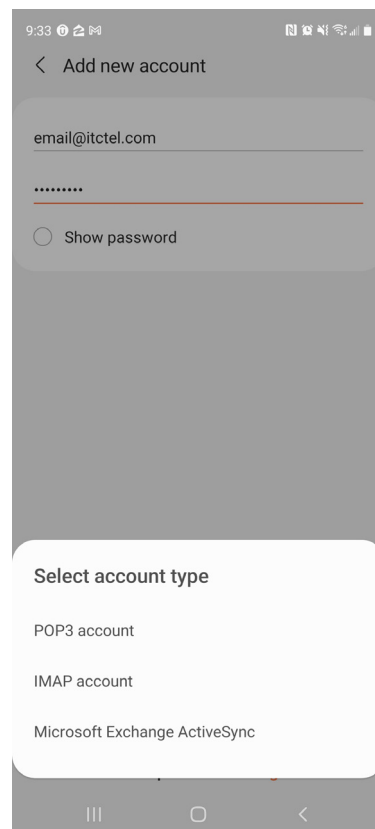
On the Set Up Email screen, touch the Other button.

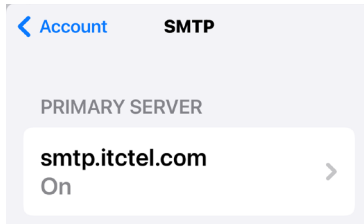
You need to verify a couple of settings. Go back to the new account you just added and open it by touching the button. In this example I would touch helpdesk@itctel.com.

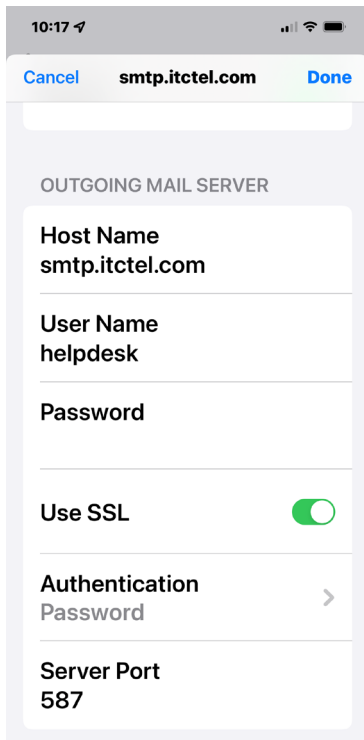
Touch the Outgoing Mail Server SMTP button, smtp.itctel.com.

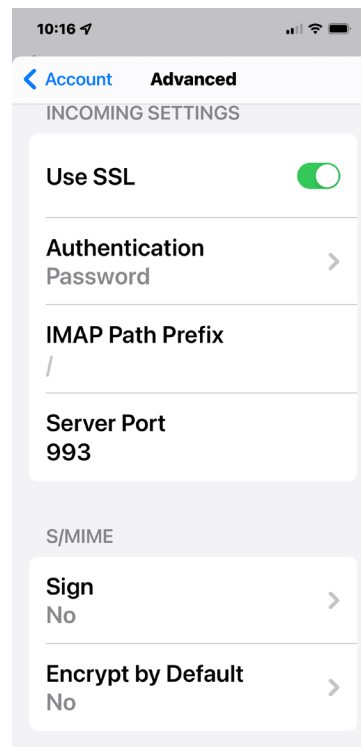


Your Outgoing Mail Server settings should be filled out like the image.

Make sure that the Authentication button says Password. If it does not say Password, then touch the Authentication button and select Password from the list.

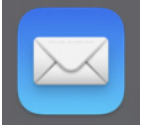

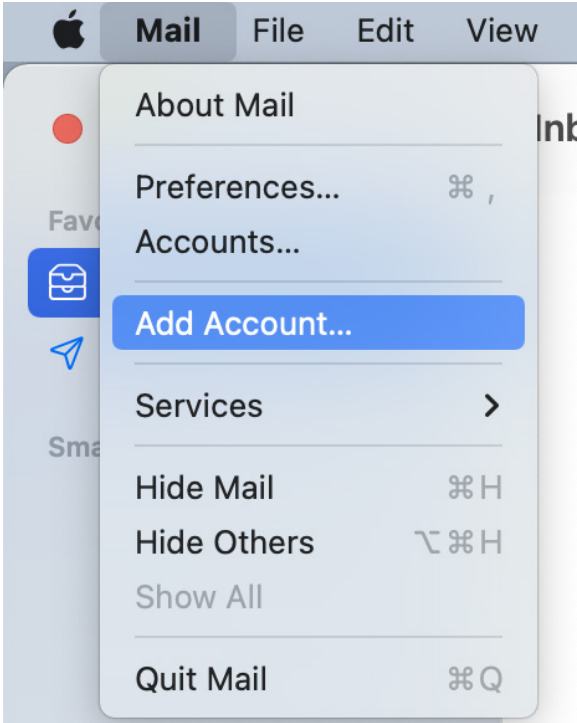

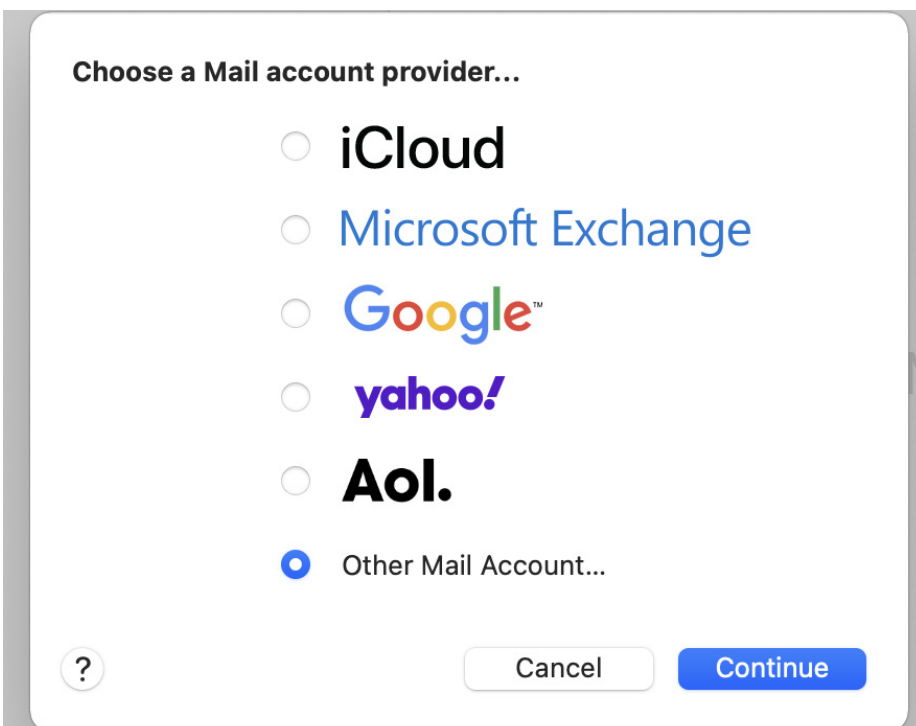
On your Mac click the Mail icon. This will open the Mail app.

In the top left corner, click Mail. In the dropdown menu click Add Account.



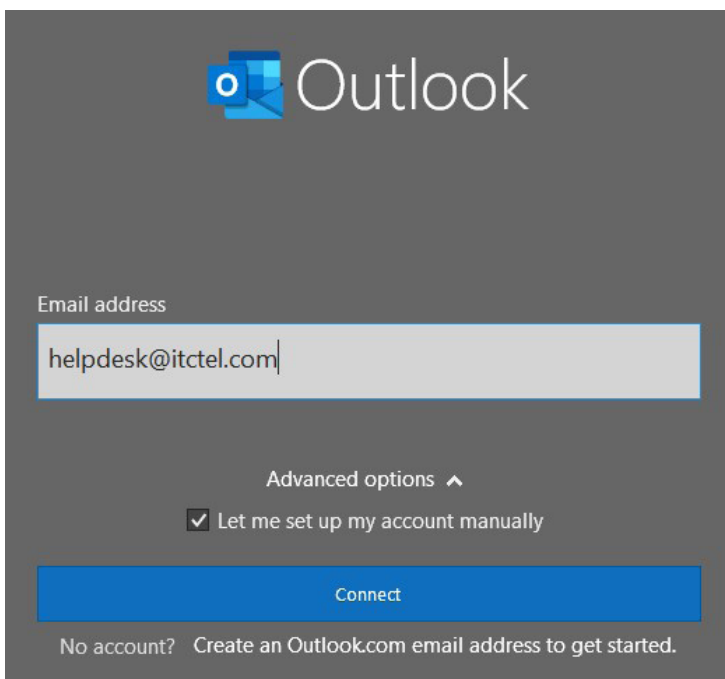
Open Outlook. Click File → Account Settings → Account Settings.

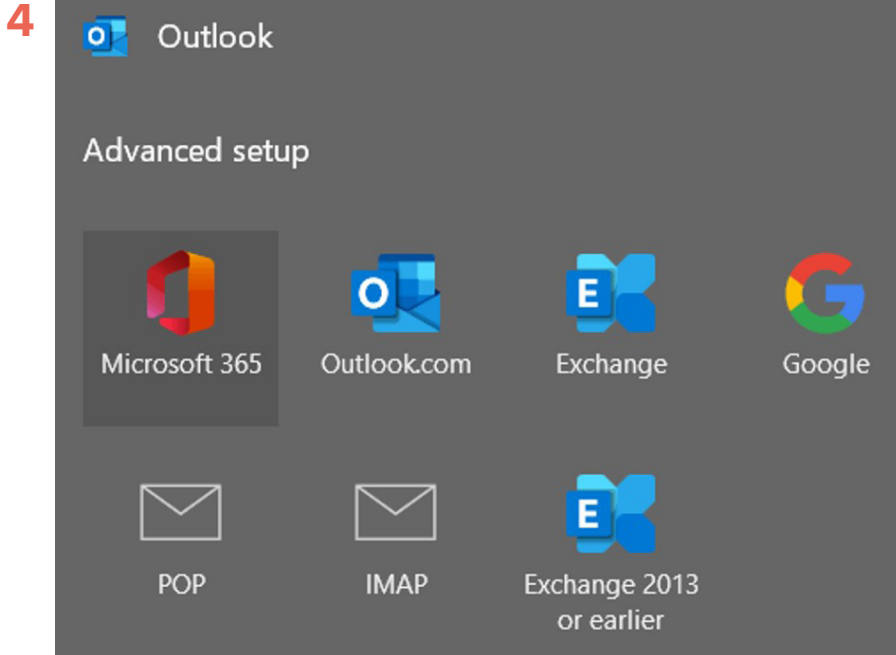

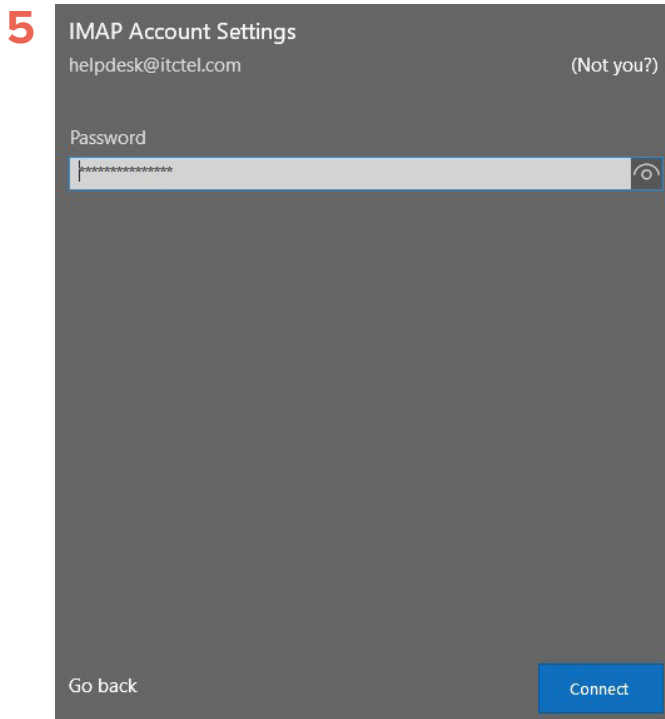


Enter your email address and click the Advanced Options button. Click the “Let me set up my account manually” checkbox. Click the Connect button.

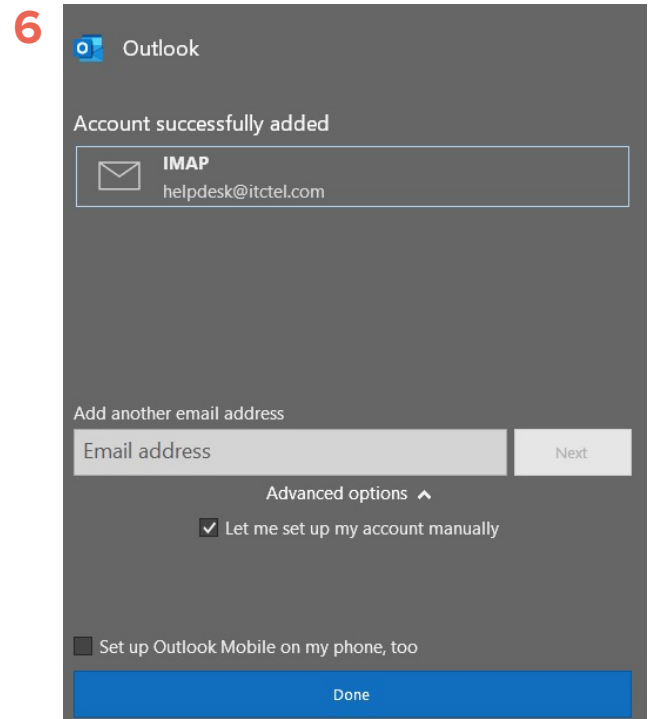
# Outlook

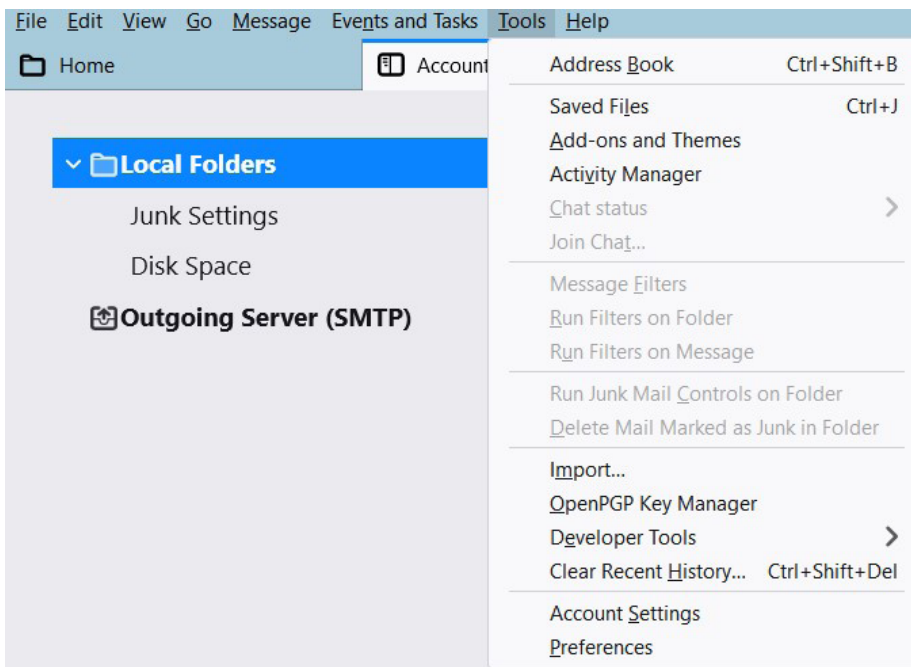
Enter your password for your email account and click the Connect button. If prompted for any values, please consult the IMAP chart.



Your email should be successfully set up. Click the Done button.

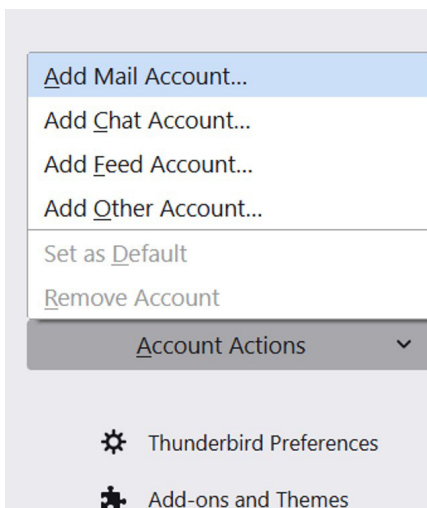
# Thunderbird

If you are using Thunderbird for your email, first press the Alt button on your keyboard. This will reveal the toolbar at the top of the screen. Click Tools and then Account Settings.

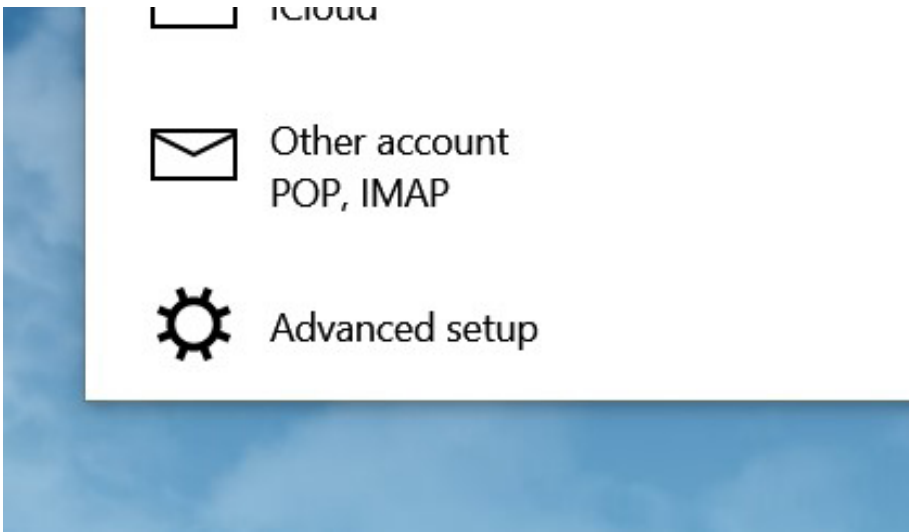

# Windows Mail
