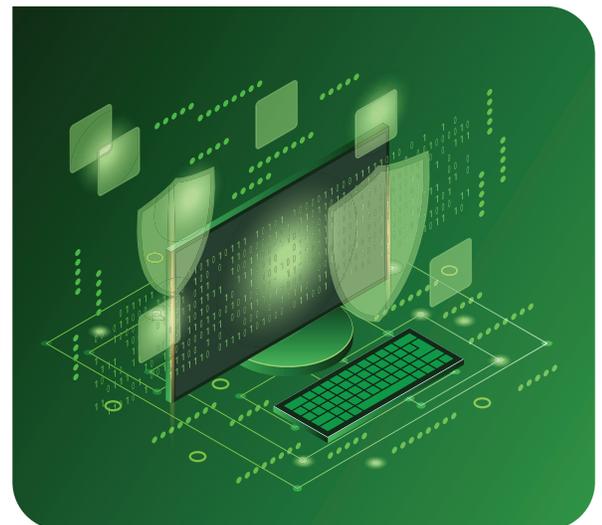

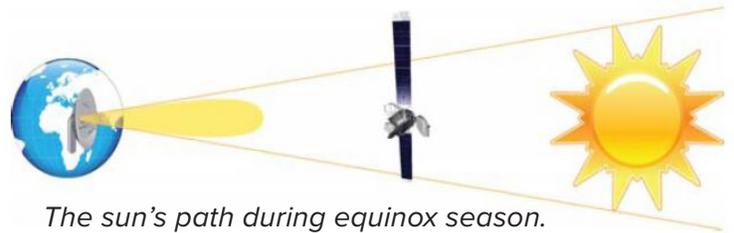

Have you cashed your check? If you still need to cash your capital credits check from ITC, please cash it at your earliest convenience.

Taxes: Every year, Coop members receive notice of the patronage credits they earned the previous year.

Current tax laws say that no part of the capital credits allocated to Cooperative patrons is subject to taxation until paid in cash.

When patrons receive cash for allocated credits, they are only subject to taxation to the extent that the payment for services was deducted on the income tax return for the year the credit was allocated.
